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HISTORY

Located in Kolkata and named after the legendary maestro Satyajit Ray, the Satyajit Ray Film & Television Institute was the second national centre of cinema education established in 1995 by the Government of India as an autonomous academic institution under the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting. The Institute was subsequently registered under the West Bengal Societies Registration Act, 1961.

The first session began on September 1, 1996. Presently the Institute conducts three year postgraduate programmes in cinema in six specializations of film making; Direction and Screenplay Writing, Editing, Cinematography, Sound Recording and Design, Producing for Film & Television, Animation Cinema and Two year postgraduate programmes in Electronics and Digital Media in six specializations; Electronic and Digital Media Management, Writing for Electronic and Digital Media, Direction & Producing for Electronic and Digital Media, Cinematography for Electronic and Digital Media, Editing for Electronic and Digital Media & Sound for Electronic and Digital Media.

The Institute also conducts short courses on film appreciation, acting, library science, digital editing and so on. The Institute has achieved significant success within its short period of existence. This has led to an attempt towards a new paradigm of specialized practices and new courses. Our alumni have been winning accolades regularly through their masterly innovations. They have been trend-setters, changing the course of film-making through a fusion of thought, craft and entrepreneurial abilities. By proving their mettle as dedicated professionals, they have increased the acceptability of current students in the complex and competitive world of cinema.

In 2017, the Institute established the Electronic & Digital Media wing of SRFTI.





AT THE HELM

Director: Shri Himansu Sekhar Khatua

Himansu Sekhar Khatua is an Indian filmmaker, educationalist, and journalist. He directed the national film award-winning movies *Sunya Swarupa* and *Kathantara* in 1996 and 2005, respectively. He served as the managing director of Kalinga Media and Entertainment Private Limited (KMEPL), as well as the CMD of Kalinga TV, a news channel, and KNews Odisha, a digital platform.

After receiving his professional training in cinema from the Film and Television Institute of India, award-winning filmmaker Himanshu Khatua delved deeply into the domain of filmmaking. Khatua relocated to Mumbai in the 1990s to work as a professional Sound Recordist, but after a year he made the decision to return to his native Odisha to do something for his own State. He did the sound design for *Indradhanura Chhai* (Shadows of the Rainbow).

His debut film, *Shunya Swarupa* (Contours of the Void), took him to international film festivals including Rotterdam (Netherlands), Kinotavr (Russia), Pesan(Italy), Gothenburg (Sweden)and Valencia (Spain). The film won many state and national awards, including Best Regional Film in Oriya. His second film, *Kathantara* (Another Story), about the 1999 Odisha storm, won eight state awards. The film won best feature at the 53rd National Film Awards in 2006. His third feature film, “*Matira Bandhana*”(The Inheritance) based on ‘Trunk of Ganesha’ by Padma Shri Jayanta Mahapatra is a one of its kind movie which garnered huge appreciation in film festivals. His fourth feature *Krantidhara* (Coup de Grace), received the Asian Excellence Awards in South Korea. It got rave reviews for portraying issues of women’s empowerment.

He has been a writer, film festival jury member, and film festival organizer.

His academic and administrative journey started from the State Government Institute BPFTIO, Odisha as a senior faculty. He shifted to KIIT University as a senior member (Board of Directors) to establish three schools, School of Film, School of Fashion and School of Mass Communication. He played a vital role in introducing Filmmaking education at University level. He has simultaneously displayed commendable excellence in filmmaking, excellent leadership in the media sector, and the development of new talent for the film industry.

He has taken charge as the Director of the Satyajit Ray Film and Television Institute, a premier film institute in South Asia under the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting, Government of India.





Dean (Film)

Vipin Vijay, multiple award-winning filmmaker is an alumnus of SRFTI. He has been engaged in his search for new cinematic forms since 2000 working in the domain of creative documentary, film essay, feature film and video art. He has participated in seminars, conferences, and workshops on various themes related to cinema, visual culture, pedagogy of cinema, and has taught extensively at national film schools across the country. Also served as Academic committee member, Board of Studies, University of Calicut, Syllabus Committee Member - FTII Pune, and was a Jury member on several occasions in national and international film festivals. He has made several nationally and internationally acclaimed and awarded non-fiction and fiction works which were exhibited in film festivals of Rotterdam, Karlovy Vary, Oberhausen, São Paulo, Nantes, Montreal, Japan, Vladivostok, IFFI, IFFK etc. Recipient of film grants from Rotterdam, Gothenburg, Global Film Initiative, PSBT, IGNCA, IFA, etc, his works have also been shown under curatorial program in art museums like Serpentine Gallery, London, Alserkal Arts Foundation, Dubai, Ullens Centre for Contemporary art (UGCA) Beijing. He has received International awards, several National Awards, Kerala State Awards, Sanskriti Award for his works. The prestigious Oberhausen International Film Festival, Germany 2015 honored him with a specially curated retrospective of his works. He was the 'Film Maker in Focus' at the IDSFFK, 2017.

Dean-in-charge (ELECTRONIC & DIGITAL MEDIA)

An alumnus of FTII Pune, Chandan Goswami has got nearly 25 years of work experience in the film & television industry. He started his career as associate cameraman in feature films like Zubeida, NETAJI – THE FORGOTTEN HERO both directed by Mr. Shyam Benegal. Later he independently shot many feature films which includes Hindi [Hera-Hoda aka Blind Camel, Trisha, Morning Walk, Monica, Das Capital etc.] and Bengali [Half Serious, Bari tar Bangla, Bonku Babu, Daker Saaj etc.] as Director of Photography. Apart from these, he has shot several documentaries [Sahitya Academi: directed by Gulzar], Television shows [IC 814 Hijack for National Geographic, Tehreer Munshi Premchand Ki by Gulzar, Mano Ya Na Mano by Siddharth Kak for Star One, Gutur Gu for SAB TV, Chatrapati Shivaji for Doordarshan] etc.

Registrar

Dr. Sushrut Sharma, a medical graduate, joined the Indian Information Service in 2014. As a civil servant, he has served in various capacities in the media units of the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting, Government of India.

As Assistant Director DDNEWS, he oversaw newsroom assignment, Editor-in-Charge of the bilingual news channel. He was also responsible for administration and human resource management. He served in the PMO before joining the Satyajit Ray Film and Television Institute. He travelled extensively with the Hon'ble President and the Hon'ble Prime Minister of India. He had travelled to Mauritius, Madagascar, and Kyrgyzstan on official assignments. Dr. Sharma attended the inaugural BRICS Youth Summit in 2015, which was hosted by Russia and where young leaders from the five BRICS nations discussed the Information and media scenario.

DEPARTMENT OF DIRECTION & SCREENPLAY WRITING





About the Department

The Direction and Screenplay Writing Department coordinates the 2 Semesters of the Integrated Program. The Department also conducts the 4 Semesters of Specialisation which include theoretical and practical inputs in Film Language and Syntax, Film History, Film Theory, Screenplay Writing and Production Design. The Department teachers engage with students on a one on one level and mentor them through all the stages of their student film projects.

We strive to provide our students with optimum exposure to different forms and genres of Cinema - be it Fiction or Documentary Cinema. In addition to our regular academic inputs, we also invite guest filmmakers to conduct film workshops with our students and to inspire them. The intent is to encourage our students to always be open to and embrace new and innovative praxis and ideas. The Department strives towards achieving not only greater technical and craft expertise for our students but also attempts to help them acquire an aesthetic sensibility, a greater understanding of and sensitivity towards societal issues. We hope to provide our students with a supportive environment where they can freely explore the film medium and move towards finding their own unique voice.

Course Objective

SEMESTER I AND SEMESTER II : Integrated Programme

Theory and practical classes will enable the student to achieve comprehension of the creative collaboration required of the existing 6 academic departments (Direction & SPW, Editing, Cinematography, Sound Recording and Design, Producing for Film & Television and Animation Cinema) in filmmaking.

SEMESTER III

The department adapts a praxis, where through focused theoretical classes, hands on practical sessions, individual mentoring and workshops with outside experts the student gains experiential understanding of the salient aspects of filmmaking.

SEMESTER IV

Each student of the department has to work with the student crew, pitch and execute a long take exercise to create cinematic spaces any where in the campus including the available sets in the studio floors and a short film to be made on given parameters of shooting indoor (on set) as well as outdoor.

SEMESTER V

In the first part of the semester two workshops are arranged, one on playback and how the same can be used effectively in narratives and the second one is on promotional and advertising filmmaking practices. Students then receive intensive inputs on research and development of non-fiction cinema and make an observational documentary. Rest of the semester then is on developing the thesis film screenplay.

SEMESTER VI

Each student along with a students' crew make a thesis film. The film can be set anywhere in India and the unit has to source all the materials including equipment and other logistics from outside. This gives the experience of real filmmaking.





FACULTY

Anirban Datta

Professor, Direction (HOD)

Anirban Datta did his PG Diploma in Cinema from Satyajit Ray Film & Television Institute (SRFTI), Kolkata in Direction and Screenplay Writing (2001-2004). Tetris (2006), his diploma film premiered at festival de Cannes'06 in Cinefondation competition. After graduating from SRFTI he directed and produced several commissioned or internationally co-produced documentaries for international broadcasters of the likes of NHK Japan, YLE Finland, VPRO Netherlands, & Doordarshan, India. The films travelled over two hundred international festivals, received numerous national and international awards and recognitions including three Rajat Kamal – Indian National Film awards. He held faculty position at Film Direction & Screenplay Dept., (FTII) Pune as Associate Professor (2019-20), and Asst. Professor (2012-13). He was also Associate Professor at Script Writing and Direction dept., K R Narayanan National Institute for Visual Science & arts, Kerala in 2017. He also conducted country's first ever workshop on filmmaking with smart phones for SKIFT (a Skill India Initiative of FTII Pune) supported by the Indian Army at Baramulla, J&K. He has served as a jury member, for 56th Indian National Film awards ; member of jury committee, NSFA, FTII Pune 2012.

Putul Mahmood

Associate Professor (Script Writing)

Putul Mahmood, an alumna of FTII, is a filmmaker, producer and teacher. She is the Producer of the Indie Bengali feature film Cosmic Sex. The film premiered at the Osian's Cinefan Festival of Arab and Asian Cinema where it won the Best Actress Award. She has directed several short fiction and documentary films including You Who Never Arrived featuring Irrfan Khan and Geetanjali Kulkarni, Man of Silence- Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel, I Shoot U, Atasi, Three Sisters and Kajal. Atasi won the Best Film Silver Conch at MIFF 2020. Putul Mahmood also worked as a Script Consultant on shorts and feature films - Serious Men featuring Nawazuddin Siddiqui, on Netflix is one of her recent works in that capacity. Putul has designed and been the Course Director of Docurama a residential Documentary Workshop and Appreciation course, the first of its kind, in collaboration with Siddhartha Kak and the IDC department of IIT Powai.

Tridip Poddar

Associate Professor (Direction)

An alumnus of SRFTI (2000), Tridip had taught in the Dept. of Mass Communication & Videography, St. Xavier's College, Kolkata for 4 years before joining SRFTI in 2011. He has been associated with KIIT, Bhubaneswar and D J Academy, Coimbatore as a visiting faculty. While freelancing he worked both in fiction & non-fiction. His first independent short fiction film Sahore (In The City, 2005), participated in many festivals including Toronto International Film Festival (2006), Kolkata Film Festival (Indian Select section, 2005). His diploma film Khoj (In Search) made in SRFTI in 2000 was the first Indian film to get an Official Selection (In Competition) in the Cinefondation section of Cannes Film Festival (2002). It also won the Best First Film of a Director award (IDPA) in Mumbai International Film Festival (MIFF, 2004) and Best Director (Short Film) by Bengal Film Journalists' Association Awards (BFJA, 2002). and Best Director (Short Film) by Bengal Film Journalists' Association Awards (BFJA, 2002).





Madhavi Tangella

Assistant Professor (Direction)

Tangella Madhavi is an award winning independent documentary film maker. She has made films for PSBT, Films Division, Majlis, Metropolis-VPRO Netherlands and NHK Japan. She has also taught documentary film making at Sophia Polytechnic and been a documentary mentor for Idocs (Documentary Resource Initiative), Documentor (Imphal) and was on the selection committee for International Documentary for Mumbai International Film Festival, 2015. An alumni of SRFTI, Asian Film Academy, Mumbai University and Sophia Polytechnic, Tangella Madhavi's core area of interests are research, Indian documentaries, and writing.

Ranajit Gharai

Assistant Professor (Art Direction)

An alumnus of FTII Pune, Ranajit Gharai has got 15 years of work experience as an Art Director /Production Designer. He has done several feature films in this capacity. Ranajit worked in the Production Design team of "Ek Nadir Golpo". This film was India's entry for the Asian , African and Latin American competition segment of the 38th International Film Festival of India, held in Goa 2007. "Udedh Bun" won Silver Bear in 2008 at 58th Berlin International Film festival 2008 and National Film award for best short fiction film 2008. Ranajit has designed for many advertisements such as for Amazon, Ambuja cement, Ozone, wedding collection-from PC Chandra Jewellers and has done Art Direction for 50 short films.

Sounak Kar

Assistant Professor (Direction)

Sounak is an alumni of Direction and Screenplay Writing department in Satyajit Ray Film and Television Institute (SRFTI). Apart from directing and writing, he works occasionally as a cinematographer, editor and sound designer. He has made films in various languages like Bengali, English, Hindi, Nepali, Nyishi, Galo, Apatani and Mandarin. His diploma film, "Sex with a monk and other stories" got screened at several major festivals of India and won the Audience Choice Award at Contact International Students Film Festival of Izmir, Turkey in 2017. In 2014, he directed two short segments for the "World from dawn to dusk: Kolkata" project as part of a workshop conducted by the National film school, Lodz, Poland. In 2015, he participated in the 'Looking China' project organized by AICCC, China and made a short documentary in Guiyang called Half Mountain. He worked as cinematographer and editor for the documentary, "Slave garden" (Aka: High tea) which received the IDFA Bertha Fund for development in 2017. It was also selected for pitching at Doc Lisboa and Doc Incheon. In 2019, he wrote, directed, shot and edited a Galo language feature film called Bird Thief – a regional film made in collaboration with the people of the Galo tribe in Basar, Arunachal Pradesh. It was exhibited in several community halls across the state. In 2020, he wrote and directed a commercial Bengali comedy web series called "Fish and Chips".

DEPARTMENT OF CINEMATOGRAPHY





About the Department

The department was incubated and setup under the guidance of Shri Subrata Mitra, the great Indian maestro who pioneered new trends in cinematographic practices. His indelible memory continues to be a guiding light for the department. The department aspires to prove worthy of the benchmarks set by him, both in academics and in the exciting practice of cinematography in today's creative flux. The department strives towards developing cinematography as an area of technical expertise through theoretical and experimental approaches, in consonance with the aims and objectives of the institute. To that end, the department views the practice of cinematography as an integral field of collaboration in the process of filmmaking and propagates the vision that students exhibit their skills in a production of professional scale through the final dissertation project.

Course Objective

A thorough engagement in "What you see is what you get" method of cinematography using Rec. 709 baked in image mode on digital platform is what students practice in the beginning of specialization. This ensures a clear conceptual and practical knowledge about the fundamental of digital cinematography. Studio and Location Lighting, Digital Theory, Cinematography Optics, Color Management from Pre-visualization through Post Production and introductory engagement with the allied areas of aesthetics are elucidated. Taught input culminates in lighting simulation exercise on set and location. In this phase students do multiple workshops on studio and location with master cinematographers.

The students evolve into the use of RAW image grabbing mode and Advance Color Management Practice in the following modules. This is a great opportunity (due to the availability of various choices of colour spaces and a variety of digital systems) for developing a thorough grasp of digital cinematography theory, testing and understanding.

Students are given diverse and intense exposure to both realistic and stylized cinematographic practice targeted at both theatrical and other media release platforms.

An alumni of FTII, Pune, Samiran Datta has got 18 years of work experience that includes ten feature films to his credit as DOP along with several Documentaries, AD films etc. Films shot by him have been showcased in leading international film festivals including Venice, Rotterdam, Moscow and Chicago. Four films shot by Samiran have bagged national awards as best film in India and Bangladesh. His nonfiction works have been showcased in BBC, NGC, CNN and YLE Thema. 'Meherjaan' a fiction feature on Bangladesh war of independence has won him best cinematography award in Hobocan international film festival, USA. The same film has also bagged an Accolade award for excellence [USA] for best cinematography. Beyond Cinema and Cinematography, Samiran has a keen interest in new media art.

Apart from shooting films as a Cinematographer, Hitesh also writes and directs short films and does Street Photography with his Celluloid still camera. His short films have been selected for international festivals across the globe in the countries like Turkey, Italy, Uruguay and Spain and have won awards.

DEPARTMENT OF EDITING





About the Department

The department creates a stimulating and supportive learning environment for students working individually and in groups to ensure that they play determining roles as professionals with creative contribution in a variety of media related vocations. Our objective is to endow students with comprehensive theoretical as well as intense hands-on training with state-of-the-art technology used in contemporary professional practices worldwide.

Course Objective

INTEGRATED COURSE

Students are introduced to the basic grammar of editing and taught to create a narrative in audio visual form, by manipulating space and time on-screen. Simultaneously, they are also taught about the historical evolution of the craft of editing. During their practical sessions, students edit several short exercises on Digital Non Linear Editing Systems. At the end of the integrated course, each student directs and edits a short film as the term-ending project.

SPECIALIZATION

In specialization, there are in-depth theory classes about the concepts of pace and rhythm, handling of time, continuity, and the other tools that an editor has to tell a story effectively. Students are also introduced to the major film movements in history (both in fiction and documentary), with special emphasis on the editing styles and conventions.

A thorough grounding in digital theory (basic concepts of computer technology, analog and digital video, compression formats and different media) is given to ensure students are at ease in the modern digital post-production environment.

Throughout the specialization modules, students continue to edit various kinds of exercises like dialogue-based dramas, action sequences, musical sequences, advertisements, promos and documentaries on DNLE systems.

In addition to theory and practical classes, there are up to eight workshops conducted by respected industry professionals on subjects like Graphics and Compositing, Digital intermediates, Basic Sound Design and Digital Post Production workflow.

Saikat Shekhareswar Ray

Assistant Professor (Editing) & HOD (IC)

Holder of Post Graduate Diploma in Editing from SRFTI, Kolkata. Worked as the chief editor with a number of well-known directors, in projects commissioned by National and International television channels and foundations. He has received National Awards 2007 (best editing non-feature)- 'Hope Dies Last in War' IDPA 2008 (Gold Award for best editing short fiction)- 'Dhin Tak Dha' IDPA 2009 (Gold Award for best editing, documentary)-Many Stories of Love & Hate. Sankhajit Biswas has studied Film Editing at SRFTI (2002-05). He has participated at the Berlinale Talent Campus 2010. He has edited many films, both fiction and documentary format, that have been screened and awarded at major international film festivals including Berlin, Toronto, Moscow, BFI London, Goteborg, IDFA, DokLeipzig, Busan, Hong Kong, Asia Pacific Screen Award, Museum of Modern Arts (MOMA) New York, Film Southasia, IFFI Goa, Jio MAMI, IFF Kerala and many more. Eight of his edited films have won National Film Awards of India and twelve have been selected for Indian Panorama including two as Opening Films. 'Hridoy Bosot' / 'A Home for My Heart' (2022), his first feature length documentary was screened at the Jio MAMI Mumbai Film Festival, Indian Film Festival of Melbourne, IDSFF Kerala, Liberation Doc Fest, Dhaka and won Jury's Special Mention at Signs Film Festival, Kerala.

The departmental classroom and conference room are equipped with modern projection. and sound systems for previews, discussions and workshops. Analogue systems of Editing are still in operation which make the students understand filmmaking technology from it's basics.





DEPARTMENT OF SOUND RECORDING & DESIGN





About the Department

Satyajit Ray Film & Television Institute is one of the few existing film schools which have been producing seasoned professionals in Sound Recording and Design. Students are trained in on location recording, studio recording, film dubbing and sound mixing on state-of-the-art consoles.

Students develop a keen ear for their aural environment and learn to appropriate the same for images through location sound recording, audio post-production, and sound design.

The course in Sound Recording and Design includes intense exposure to the Indian film and music industry in the form of numerous workshops conducted by eminent professionals.

Course Objective

The objective of the first two semesters of the integrated course is to give the students a firm foundation in the theory of sound recording with special emphasis on audio theory. The course assumes knowledge of science only up to the school level. Therefore, significant amount of time is initially given to revision of the basic concepts of physics and mathematics.

Students are, in their specialization, progressively exposed to the finer intricacies of acoustics, microphone, loudspeaker, theory of sound recording and other related subjects along with intensive practical modules in music recording, foley recording, sound designing, mixing, and location recording through guided tutoring, practices, workshops and project work. Simultaneously they learn about digital and analog audio theory, multichannel surround formats, and as well as the fundamentals of electronics with greater emphasis on location recording.

The journey in the department is further enriched by multilayered skill development and dedicated programme on higher level of applications in planning, designing and execution of fiction narrative for dissertation submission.

Sukanta Majumdar is a sound designer who specialises in field recording and sound design for films and theatre. A graduate of the Satyajit Ray Film and Television Institute of India in Kolkata, he has worked with many renowned filmmakers at home and abroad. Sukanta's recent work includes a soundtrack for artist Moad Musbahi at the ongoing Singapore Biennale 2022, soundtracks for an exhibition, A Slightly Curving Place at HKW, Berlin in 2020 which travelled later to Alserkal, Dubai in 2021, and a soundtrack for a recently released album, Anthology of Exploratory Music from India. (2020) and The Scent of Earth (2021), Anynadin... (Another Day...) DEPARTMENT OF PRODUCING FOR FILM & TELEVISION





About the Department

The Department of Producing for Film & Television is one its kind of under Government initiative in the country which provides a Post Graduate Program in Cinema at international standards.

The Producing for Film and Television is a perfect combination of business and creativity, where entrepreneurial skills and storytelling expertise are a must. The Creative Producers generate and cultivate projects from the initial idea phase to its completion, with an intense focus on the story but also an understanding of commercial viability.

Course Objective

To Understand how to tell a good story and how to reach an audience are basic skills that every good producer possesses — whether for movies or television. For this the entire curriculum is built around the dual focus of development and strategy.

The Post Graduate in Cinema program is totally project-oriented. Working under realistic conditions, students from the different disciplines i.e. Scriptwriting & Direction, Cinematography, Sound Recording & Design, Editing and Producing profiles collaborate to create and produce a number of short and documentaries on different formats.

The lectures and workshops by industry experts, and particularly in the mentored practical work, they are taught the following subjects: script analysis, pitching, casting, budgeting, financing, production phases, marketing, media law and management. This program provides the aspiring producer with a demanding, yet practical framework to cultivate their business and creative skills in order to become an active and successful member of the film industry.

With a distinguished visiting faculty, the Department’s faculty is equipped to teach Hand Drawn Classical Animation as well as Computer aided Animation techniques, Sequential Art, Game Design and Visual Effects. Drawing out the collaborative spirit of movie making, the Department has an open and inclusive philosophy to function as a crucible for the aesthetics and sensibilities of modern moving image making.

Course Objective

Animation activity in our country has largely been that of creating humor by moving simple cartoons about. And in doing so, we seem to have easily adopted a way of telling that is much away from our true sensibilities. Very rarely has Animation here been seen as a form of Cinema that can provoke thought, entertain, educate and inform with true dynamics of able narratives. 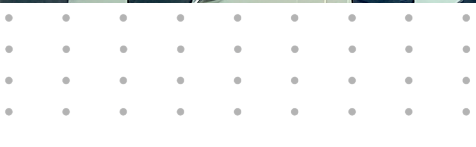
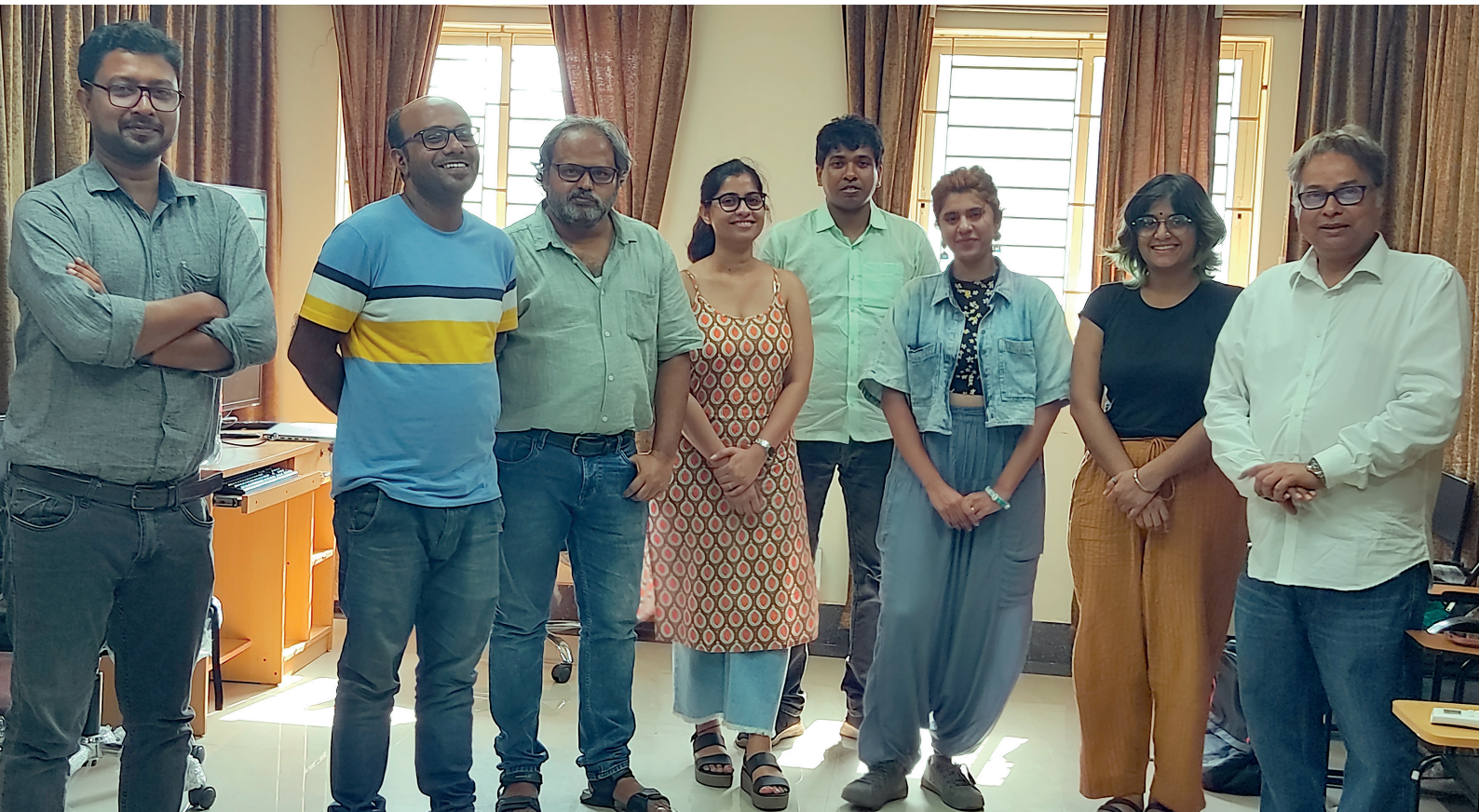

DEPARTMENT OF WRITING FOR ELECTRONIC & DIGITAL MEDIA





About the Dept.

The EDM Writing course, with a liberal and 'hands-on' approach; is geared towards training and prepping students to become professional content writers/ creators/ in the electronic & digital media entertainment industry such as television and OTT platforms. The main thrust of the course, therefore, is given to the concept of 'Practice makes perfect'.

COURSE OBJECTIVE

EDM Writing students are taken through the 2 year intensive, exhaustive and exciting process of learning the craft of screenwriting for the electronic and digital media. They will be encouraged, not only to discover their own talent and abilities ; but steered, and mentored to shape and hone them into full-fledged skills, aided by the requisite writing tools, language, grammar etc. which they will be taught systematically. Students will have the opportunity to explore with guidance, various fiction genres like Drama, Thriller and Comedy and formats such as the half hour daily soap, sitcom, one hour drama, web series, Web short and radio drama. They will also receive input in non-fiction formats across EDM such as Documentary and News & Current Affairs.

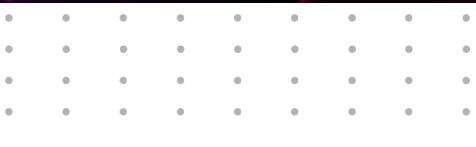

About the Department

The Department of Direction & Producing for Electronic & Digital Media conducts a little over three semesters of specialization which includes theoretical and practical inputs, guest lectures, workshops as well as exercises and projects. Students are taught the grammar of audio visual communication, given an exposure to different genres of both fiction and non-fiction programs for OTT platforms and Television. The theoretical input is supplemented by practical classes where students pick up the necessary skills for both single camera (fiction and nonfiction) and multi camera production. The department is equipped with 4K video cameras, DSLRs, professional microphones and editing systems, allowing students to master the basics of all aspects of production through the practical classes. These theoretical and practical inputs are interspersed with exercises where students perform various roles in multi camera productions of music, news and sports shows, as well as projects like documentary, short fiction and the diploma production, where students are mentored individually by the faculty through every step of the process.

Course Objective

The course is oriented towards equipping students with the skills and knowledge of the craft necessary to excel in careers in OTT and television direction and production. Graduating students should be able to work as program producers for television channels, producing news, sports, music or other live shows. They would also be able to create and direct fiction shows for OTT platforms and television. They can also work as independent fiction filmmakers and documentary filmmakers. The course also gives students an exposure to the overall OTT and television market, which would aid students to plan their career paths in the fast-changing times.

COURSE OVERVIEW

Integrated Semester

The program consists of four semesters. The first part of the program is an integrated course. Students are exposed to the basics of each of the six specializations as well as an overview of the broad spectrum of arts (literature, music, drama, etc.) and their relation with the audio visual arts. Students will also be given hands on training in each of the specializations through practical classes. Finally, the students bring together their knowledge of the theory and practice that they have acquired by working on a collaborative short fiction project.

Specialization Semesters

In the specialization part of the program, students are imparted more advanced knowledge in their respective specializations through :

- Theory classes with internal faculty
- Advanced Practical classes
- Workshops / Masterclass with industry professionals
- Collaborative projects , exercises, demos, etc.

Students will be imparted training in:

- Fiction for web and television
- Multicamera operations
- News & Current Affairs Programs
- Documentary
- Live sports programs
- Live music programs





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ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATION

3 year Post Graduate Programme in Cinema

Graduate in any discipline from a recognized university or equivalent. The candidates who have not received their graduation degree before the application date are required to submit the same before the date of admission. For Animation Cinema, candidates should have proficiency in drawing.

2 year Post Graduate Programme in Electronic & Digital Media

Graduate in any discipline from a recognized university or equivalent. The candidates who have not received their graduation degree before the application date are required to submit the same before the date of admission.

ADMISSION PROCESS

The admission process consists of nationally administered Joint Entrance Test (JET) for admission to SRFTI & FTII, followed by subsequent rounds of Orientation and Interview. The students are selected on the basis of their JET scores, and performance in the orientation & interviews. Candidates should note that the mere fulfillment of minimum eligibility criteria will not ensure consideration for short listing by the institute.

The written test will be of 3 hours for 100 marks. Question papers will be divided into two parts.

Paper I:

Part A: Multiple Choice Questions (Single Answer type) 20 marks [on OMR sheet]

Part B: Multiple Select Answer type Questions (MSQs) 20 marks [on OMR sheet]

Paper II:

Descriptive Answer type Questions 60 marks.

Paper-I and Paper-II of all the eligible appeared candidates will be evaluated.

On the basis of performances in the written test of JET 2023-24, the list of short listed candidates for Orientation Course (OC) and Interview will be announced. For all common courses of SRFTI & FTII, online OC & interview will be held jointly whereas for all stand alone courses, online OC & interview will be held separately. The final merit list for admission will be prepared based on 20% marks of Written Test, 50% marks of OC and 30% marks of Interview subject to qualifying Medical Test.

For OC & Interview candidates will be short listed as per the following ratio against each seat:

- i) Unreserved, OBC_NCL and Gen_EWS: 1:3 (One seat:3 candidates)
- ii) SC, ST, Gen_PwD, OBC_NCL_PwD and Gen_EWS_PwD: 1:5 (One seat: 5 candidates)
- iii) SC_PwD and ST_PwD: 1:7 (One seat:7 candidates)

Counselling for all PG Diploma Courses of Film Wing & EDM Wing Joint Orientation and Joint Interview of respective Film Courses (Direction & Screenplay Writing, Cinematography, Editing and Sound Recording & Sound Design) of FTII, Pune and SRFTI, Kolkata, will be jointly held in online mode and course wise joint merit list will be published. Similarly, Joint Orientation and Joint Interview of respective EDM Courses of SRFTI (Direction & Producing for EDM, Cinematography for EDM, Editing for EDM and Sound for EDM) and respective TV courses of FTII, Pune will be jointly held in online mode and course wise joint merit list will be published. Alongwith above, merit list of all remaining standalone courses will also be published. After publishing all merit lists, preference of Institute will be obtained from the short listed candidates for admission. Based on the preference and merit, candidates will be selected to a particular course in FTII or SRFTI. This counselling may be carried out offline in Pune/ Mumbai/ Kolkata OR online OR through system software etc. Necessary information in this regard will be published on the website.

Candidates can apply for maximum of 3 courses, any one from each group as mentioned. Multiple applications in any one group will be summarily rejected.

Candidates must read & agree to the contents/ rules/ instructions as published in the prospectus. After submitting the application form it will be presumed that they have fully understood and accepted the same.

The Bachelor's degree obtained through Indian University/ Foreign University/ State University/ Private University and /or equivalent must be recognized by the University Grants Commission (UGC) / Association of Indian Universities (AIU) of India. Candidate must submit said recognition (which must be valid for the course & duration of studies in the said University/ Institute) at the time of document verification, failing which such academic qualification will not be considered and the candidature will be cancelled. Also, candidates claiming Diploma courses equivalent to Bachelor's degree must submit equivalence certificate from University Grants Commission (UGC) of India or from Competent Govt. Authority. If any relevant certificate is not in Hindi or English language, duly certified translated equivalent certificate in Hindi or English, notarized by a public Notary, must be submitted at the time of document verification. Without it, the candidate will lose the claim against such a certificate.



The onus of obtaining of recognition certificate lies with the concerned candidate. Degree(s) obtained through Open University / Distance Education mode, needs to be recognised by Distance Education Council, Ministry of Human Resource Development. Unless such Degree(s) had been recognised for the period when the candidates required qualification, it will not be accepted. The onus of obtaining recognition certificate lies with the concerned candidate and must be submitted at the time of document verification, failing which candidate will not be allowed to participate in further admission process.

If any relevant certificate is not in Hindi or English language, duly certified translated equivalent certificate in Hindi or English, notarized by a public Notary, must be submitted at the time of document verification. Without it, the candidate will lose the claim against such a certificate.

The medium of instruction at SRFTI is mainly English. Candidate must have an adequate knowledge of English and/or Hindi as regards to reading, writing and speaking.

The Status of all candidates is strictly provisional. The mere fact that Admit Card or Hall ticket has been issued and the candidate is allowed to appear in the written test will not imply that SRFTI has accepted the candidature in finality.

Candidates already admitted to any other Full Time course or employed will be required to produce a withdrawal / resignation certificate from the institution/ organization concerned at the time of admission. Students are not allowed to be engaged academically or professionally with any other educational/ occupational institute or organization.

No Travelling Allowance or any other allowance will be paid to candidates at any stage of examination or admission.

No change in written examination/ Audition/ Orientation/ Interview/ reporting date will be entertained.

Admission of a candidate will be provisional till all admission formalities are completed which may even extend after commencement of the academic session.

Ragging in any form inside and outside of the SRFTI campus is completely banned as per existing law. Whosoever directly or indirectly commits, participates in, abets or instigates ragging within or outside SRFTI shall have to face disciplinary action as per the provisions of the law. The candidates as well as their parents, at the time of admission to the Institute will be required to furnish an undertaking in the form of an affidavit that the candidate will not indulge in any form of ragging.

Any dispute concerning SRFTI Admissions would be subject to jurisdiction of the competent courts within the territorial jurisdiction city of Kolkata only.

A candidate needs to submit a self-declaration stating his/ her medical history, in a proforma, which would be provided at the time of admission.

Candidates appearing for the final year of Bachelor's degree, and awaiting results, can also apply for JET 2023-24. However, it may be noted that such candidates, if selected, are allowed to join the programme, only if they submit a passing certificate from the Controller of Examinations / Principal / Registrar of their University / Institution, by 31st August, 2024 stating that they have completed all the requirements for obtaining the Bachelor's degree, on the date of the issue of the certificate.





No documents will be verified at the time of JET – 2023-24 (Written Test). Initial document verification will be carried – out during evaluation of Papers. If the claimed educational/ caste/ PwD/ OBC – NCL/ EWS etc. certificate is/ are not as per requirement, the candidature may be immediately cancelled OR will be considered as UR from the first stage of application as the case may be, subject to satisfying other conditions. In view of above, it is once again advised to all the candidates to carefully attach all the documents/ certificates etc. along-with the online application form. Only the documents submitted while applying for JET 2023-24 will be considered for matters related to admission.

NOTE:

1. All important information on admission process including any subsequent Corrigendum/ Changes/Updates shall be made available on the website only.
2. Candidates must declare and maintain a valid and unique e-mail account and a mobile phone number throughout the selection process and should simultaneously track SRFTI website for subsequent Corrigendum/Changes/Updates. SRFTI will not be responsible for any non-receipt of intimation to a candidate.

RESERVATION POLICY

Reservation of seats in each course is as per Government of India reservation rules.

- 15% seats in each specialization are reserved for candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes (SC)
- 7.5% seats in each specialization are reserved for candidates belonging to Scheduled Tribes (ST)
- 27% of the seats in each specialization are reserved for candidates belonging to non-creamy layer of the Other Backward Class (OBC-NCL)
- 5% of total seats are reserved on horizontal basis for Person with Disabilities [PwD], with 40% or more disability, cutting across all sections i.e. SC, ST, OBC Non-Creamy and General category.
- 1 seat in each specialization are reserved for candidates belonging Economically Weaker Section (EWS)

Applicants applying under these categories should declare their category in the application form itself.

Reservation Rules:

- SC/ST/PwD/ EWS candidates and candidates belonging to OBC (non-creamy layer) (as per the Central list of OBC available on website www.ncbc.nic.in) must enclose a photocopy of the certificate, either in English/ Hindi, issued by a Competent Authority in the prescribed format, while submitting the application form and while document verification. In case, the said certificates are in regional language, official translated certificates in Hindi/English, notarized by a public notary, must be submitted along with the application form and at the time of document verification. Candidates failing to meet the above requirements will be considered as general candidate from the very first stage of admission process, i.e. from the written examination stage.
- In addition to above, OBC candidates will have to satisfy the caste and creamy layer requirements detailed on the following National Commission for Backward Classes (NCBC) websites:
 - (a) www.ncbc.nic.in
- Candidates claiming OBC-NCL status may please note that the OBC certificate, including non – creamy layer status should have been issued on a date within one year before the closing date of receiving application.
- Candidates claiming PwD reservation should submit latest certificate in the prescribed form which should have been issued on a date within six months before the closing date of receiving application. Otherwise, the PwD certificate should have permanent validity.
- Certificates not fulfilling these conditions will be held invalid, and therefore unacceptable.





As per the provisions of The Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 (RPwD Act 2016), 5% of total seats are reserved for Persons with Benchmark Disabilities (PwD). "Person with benchmark disability" means a person with not less than forty percent (40%) of a specified disability where specified disability has not been defined in measurable terms and includes a person with disability where specified disability has been defined in measurable terms, as certified by the certifying authority. "Specified disability" means the disabilities as specified in the Schedule of the RPwD Act 2016. The categories of disability are:

- A. Blindness and low vision
- B. Deaf and hard of hearing
- C. Locomotor disability including cerebral palsy, leprosy cured, dwarfism, acid attack victims and muscular dystrophy.
- D. Autism, intellectual disability, specific learning disability and mental illness
- E. Multiple disabilities from amongst persons under clauses (a) to (d) Including Deaf-Blindness.
- F. Other 'specified disabilities' mentioned in 'The Schedule' of the RPwD Act 2016 The candidates with benchmark disability will be eligible for reservation under respective categories only after fulfilling other prescribed qualification requirements in this regard.

As SRFTI provides audio-visual training, following are the eligibility rules for PwD candidates.

- 1. Candidates with benchmark locomotor disability should be able to stand with aid and appliances (assistive kit) and should be able to work with both the hands.
- 2. Candidates with benchmark disabilities in the categories of "Deaf and Hard of Hearing", "Deaf-Blindness", "Blindness" and "Low Vision" should be able to use aid and appliances (assistive kit) for all operational purpose.
- 3. Candidates applying under this category should have Certificate of Disability issued as per sub-section (2) (a) of section 58 of The 66 Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016(49 of 2016) in Form V, Form VI or Form VII as per rule 18(1) of the notification vide number G.S.R. 591 (E) dated 15th June, 2017. The certificate should be issued by a medical authority designated under sub section (1) of section 57 of the act and rules 17 (a) and (b) of G.S.R. 591(E). Such candidates are required to produce the original Certificate of Disability at the time of Admission to the Institute.
- 4. The candidates suffering from following disabilities are not eligible for the specializations

(V) The candidate with benchmark disabilities has an option of making an arrangement for the writer / scribe on his / her own at the time of written test. PwD candidates bringing their own scribe need to submit the prescribed affidavit at the time of registration. Scribe must be undergraduate as far as his/her qualifications are concerned and should not have any academic qualification in film and / or television.

(VI) Candidates selected under reservations for persons with benchmark disabilities will be adjusted against the respective category i.e SC / ST / OBC / General. In other words, there will be 5% horizontal reservation for Person with benchmark Disability cutting across all sections i.e. SCs, STs, OBC-NCLs, EWS and General category. Reservation for the candidates belonging to SC, ST, OBC-NCL category is vertical reservation and persons with benchmark disabilities category reservation is horizontal reservation. Horizontal reservation cuts across vertical reservation (interlocking reservation) and candidates selected against the quota of persons with benchmark disabilities will be adjusted against the category (SC/ ST/ OBC-NCL/ General) of that particular person with benchmark disabilities candidate.)

(VII) There will be no separate question paper(s) for candidates with benchmark disabilities.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

There is a provision of enrolling one foreign student in each specialization of Film wing and Electronic and Digital Media wing. These students need to apply through the Indian Council for Cultural Relations (ICCR). Medium of instruction at SRFTI is English. The candidates will be selected on the basis of their performance in the Interview. The Academic Rules & Regulations of the Institute are applicable to the ICCR students as well with regard to eligibility, evaluation, discipline etc.





LIBRARY

Library

The library of Satyajit Ray Film & Television Institute, Kolkata, was setup in 1997. The library has been primarily designed to meet the requirements of the institute's academic programmes. It has a formidable collection of books and periodicals on cinema, sociology, arts, history and critical studies along with specialized titles dealing with the technology of cinema. At present, the library has a great collection of DVDs ranging from classics to experimental films.

The Library remains open every day except Saturday and Govt. Holidays. Reference collection including Encyclopedias, Dictionaries, Directories and Handbooks, art history and some basic books of general nature are available on open shelves on the ground floor reading hall. Only faculty members may borrow the books from Reference Section. The Lending collection includes textbooks, critical theory, film/art history, film scripts, handbooks, fiction and some basic books of general nature. The library has a large collection of audio-visual material of various genres. This collection contains students' diploma films and projects, classics, short films, documentaries and feature films.

ADMINISTRATION



SRFTI is a fully funded autonomous institution under the Ministry of Information & Broadcasting, run by a Society constituted by the Government of India. The Society, headed by a President, runs the institute through a Governing Council (GC), which includes, in addition to the experts in the field of cinema and officials of the Ministry as ex-officio members. The Governing Council forms different committees, like Standing Finance Committee, Academic Council and any other committee as it may deem fit to deliberate and recommend for taking appropriate policy decision falling within their areas of competence.

The Society, Governing Council and Standing Finance Committee have officials of Ministry of Information & Broadcasting as ex-officio members representing the Government. There is an Academic Council, which is empowered to take policy decisions as regards all academic and production-related affairs of the Institute.





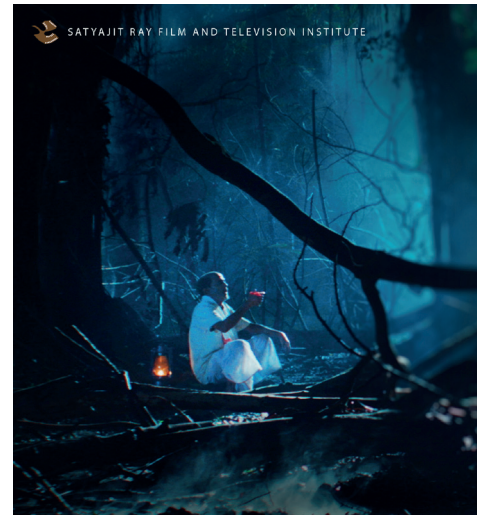

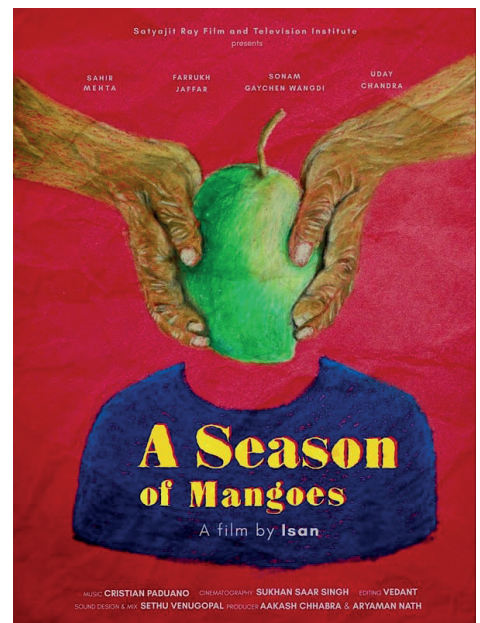
